Race information and rules

Applications to be sent to: Qormi Cycling Club, 352, Victory Street, Qormi

Eligibility: Cyclists registered with the Malta Cycling Federation for the 2010 season.

Entry Fees: €7 for Elite, Masters, 0/50,0/60 and Ladies . €3 for Juniors and U/15

Categories: Elite, Juniors, U/15, Ladies, Masters 0/40, 0/50, 0/60;

Prizes: Trophies for the first three of each category provided that at least five cyclists participate in each category. For any category with 4 participants, trophies will be presented to the first two. If the number of participants within any category is three or less, the first participant will be awarded.

A commemorative medal will be distributed to all participants.

Race Numbers: MCF race numbers are to be used.

Route of race: *Start at Triq is-Sebh Mriehel Bypass next to Wurth outlet proceeding to Mdina Road to Attard, Zaghfran Road continuing to Saqqajja Rabat. After Saqqajja, route continues via Nikola Saura Street, G. Borg Olivier Street to San Duminku Square and finally via Hal Tartarini Street to Dingli. The Finish is next to Francis Ebejer memorial in Dingli.*

It should be noted that the route is **not** traffic free. Although the route is marshalled, cyclists are urged to be cautious and to use their best judgement during the race.

Presentation: Presentation of trophies will be held at the finish after the race.

Start Time: 0730 a.m. Cyclists who are called at the starting line but do not turn up will be disqualified for the event.

Helmets: All cyclists must have protective cycling helmets during the races.

End Date: Applications are to reach Qormi Cycling Club premises by Wednesday 3rd February 2010. Late applications may not be accepted.

Malta Cycling Federation rules apply during the race.
