## ST. PAUL'S BY-PASS ROAD RACE – 7<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2010

**Race Venue:** St. Paul's By-Pass

**Race Date:** Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> March 2010

**Organized by:** Melita Pedal Power Cycling Club in collaboration with the Malta Cycling Federation

**Race Start:** 07:30 a.m. (cyclist should be present at least 15 minutes before)

**Route:** Start/Finish opposite entrance to Marsovin wineries (near 'lay-by'/belvedere) down to Burmarrad round-a-bout and up to Xemxija/Ghajj Tuffieha round-a-bout. (As usual cyclists will turn around the central strip and not round the round-a-bout. i.e. round-a-bouts are not part of the circuit)

**Race Type:** Mass Start

**Distances:** Approximate lap distance – 5.8 kms

## RACE REGULATIONS:

1. This event is being organized by the Melita Cycling Club under the auspices of the Malta Cycling Federation and shall be held in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of the M.C.F.
  2. The Entrance Fee for this event for non Club members is **€ 5.00** for Adults & **€ 2.50** for Juniors. U/15 are free of charge
  3. Cyclists are to use race numbers as assigned to them by the Malta Cycling Federation and are required to use 2 back numbers and one bike frame number.
  4. Conventional 'CE' Approved helmets are to be worn during warm-up and throughout the event.
  5. Cyclists who have finished competing in the race should refrain from cycling on the race circuit.
  6. The Start of the race will go ahead category by category, each separated by a minute, thus **NO DRAFTING** is allowed between different categories. In such situations riders will be disqualified
  7. Team vehicles shall not be allowed on the circuit although the organizer's safety car/motorcycle may be allowed on the circuit.
  8. Cyclists are not to approach the Timekeepers table for results.
  9. In the event that a cyclist has a grievance or complaint, the cyclist should advise his/her Club Delegate who should forward the grievance/complaint to the organizers through the proper channels.
  10. Cyclists must obey all instructions given by race officials or marshals and failure to obey such instructions and these regulations may result in disqualification.
  11. The awards presentation shall take place on site as soon as possible after the event.
  12. List of cyclists participating in the race & payment has to be provided by club delegates on the race meeting to be held on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2010**. No riders will be allowed to register after this date.
